- Shelving: This is the area with the most need. It involves organizing and filing returned library materials. Shelving requires a considerable amount of movement and light lifting and pushing.
- Adopt a Shelf: Pick a section of shelves which you will regularly maintain and straighten.
- Special Projects/Programs: Projects are tasks that are offered in lieu of shelving on any given day. It may include folding brochures, putting together children's craft kits, light landscaping, even cleaning. Special projects are not always available. The volunteer coordinator will approach you if there are tasks which need done.
- The Early Literacy Outreach Program: This program visits waiting rooms in Athens County to read stories, give away books, and to encourage parents to read and have rich language interactions with their children. Volunteers interested in helping with this program are required to attend a 3-hour training session with library staff held in the fall and spring. Volunteers must be able to commit to at least one hour a week for at least six months and have reliable transportation. The scheduling can be flexible.
- Booksale: The Friends of the Athens Public Library hold a booksale the 2nd Saturday of each month. To prepare for the sale, volunteers are needed to help sort, lift and move boxes of books. If you are interested, which day or days would you be able to volunteer?

 - Every 2nd Saturday 3:00–4:00 pm
